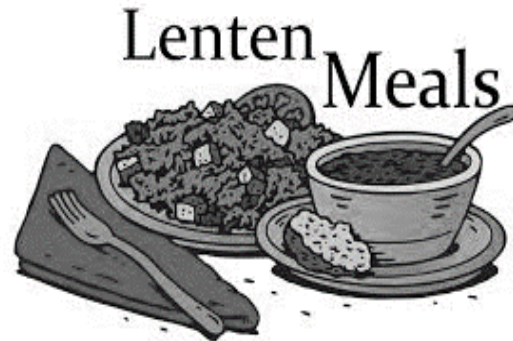
### Voters' Assembly Meeting
